Conditions of entry 2020

- 1) Entries will only be accepted upon receipt of full payment and completed entry form
- 2) Your entry fee of \$45 covers 27 holes of golf, twos, pitch for cash entry and BBQ food
- 3) Entries close on Wednesday November 25 or when fully subscribed
- 4) No entry fees will be refunded after the closing date
- 5) The draw will be emailed out to entrants (if they have provided their address) on Thursday November 26. It will be also put on the Waahi Taakaro club's website and Facebook page
- 6) Please report to the starter in the golf shop no later than 7.45am to collect your cards
- 7) There will be a course rules briefing at 8.10am
- 8) Shotgun start at 8.30am
- 9) The maximum **course** handicap for the tournament is 24 for men and 36 for women
- 10) The competition will be played in three men's grades and one women's grade
- 11) The tournament is 27 holes and will be played off the blue tees for men and yellow tees for women. The first round will be 18 holes followed by 9 holes off the front 9. There will **not** be a break between the two rounds.
- 12) Qualifying for the Pitch for Cash final will be over both the morning and afternoon rounds. The final will be decided by closest to the pin from the No 9 drop zone to the No 9 flag.
- 13) In the event of a tie for the overall champion (best gross), a sudden death play-off will be held starting on No 18 tee and continuing to No 1, No 2 etc
- 14) All decisions of the match committee on the day will be final
- 15) Measuring devices for distance only are permitted
- 16) Any cancellation of the tournament will be emailed to competitors, put on the Waahi Taakaro club's website and Facebook page and broadcast on radio.
