<u>All participants will learn about</u>: Different types and makes of metal chassis and scalextric type slot cars, chassis building, dismantling and rebuilding a motor, machining a motor commutator, wiring, cutting out and painting a slot car body, soldering, trimming tyres to size, how a slot car hand controller works, and assembling a slot car ready to race.

The first of the 3 workshops starts Sunday 30 June then 21 July and 28 July

After each workshop there is an opportunity to practice with club race cars.
